

Greenroof Cost Estimate Form and Questionaire

- 1. What is the approximate age of the building?
- 2. Is the building new or will it be renovated?
- **3.** What type of a building is to be renovated or constructed, what is the principle use (i.e.2 story residential single family detached house, commercial high rise, etc.?)
- **4.** How high is the structure?
- **5.** What is the current structural decking and support system for the roof? (I.e. Is it a 5/8" plywood deck with 2"x10" joists spaced 16" o.c., a metal deck and truss system, etc?)
- **6.** Do you have any architectural plans available to determine loading requirements of the roof?
- 7. If the roof is being renovated? And if so, when was the roof last replaced?
- 8. Have you noticed any signs of current water damage?
- **9.** How many sq. ft. of the roof is planned to be vegetated?
- **10.** What is the slope of the roof? (Is it 20 degrees or less?)
- **11.** Have you had a structural evaluation done? (You should plan on having a structural evaluation completed to obtain a letter of certification from a certified structural engineer to establish loading requirements.)
- 12. If a structural evaluation has been completed how much loading can the structure support?
- **13.** What is the exposure of the roof that is looking to be installed? (Is it a southern exposure with full sun, a northern exposure and shady?)
- 14. What will be the primary function of the greenroof?
- **15.** Will there be access to the roof for routine maintenance?
- **16.** When do you wish to begin construction of the greenroof or roof garden?
- **17.** Do you wish to incorporate any other Low Impact Development (LID) techniques into the design such as installing a rain barrel for storm water harvesting?
- **18.** Please provide contact information.
