



Broadway Green, Sculpture with Nature Art Exhibit, Midtown, NYC

Date Installed: July 2012

Cube Size: 441sq. ft.

System Design: Six 3.5' steel mesh cubes filled with growing media and lined with sedum mats.

Environmental Artists: Patricia Leighton and Del Geist

General Contractor: Capitol Greenroofs LLC.

Location: Along Broadway Street between 41st and 36th Streets.

Above: Six metal frame cube structures were bolted to the ground along the pedestrian way on Broadway Street in the Fashion District of Midtown. These vegetated sculptures were spaced out along the intersections between 41st and 36th Streets.

Right: The inner cube is filled with insulation to help cut down on the overall weight of the structure. Sedum mats were then hung from the inside of the steel wire mesh, and an engineered growing media was placed behind to hold the mats against the cube surface and allow it to grow in place.



Left: This exhibit is temporary and will be on display from July 2012 to January 2013. Cubes in the distance can be seen and appear to be rolling down Broadway.
